

American Legion Auxiliary Fourth District Past Presidents Parley Scholarship Gift Rules

Eligibility:

- A. The applicant must be a daughter, son, granddaughter, grandson, great granddaughter or great granddaughter of an American Legion Auxiliary member or previous member now deceased.
- B. The applicant must be a member of the American Legion Auxiliary or the Sons of the American Legion if eligible for membership therein.
- C. The applicant must show an interest in the medical field and have a need for financial assistance in order to attend an accredited post high school institution as a full time student.
- D. The applicant must have a high average scholarship, deportment and attendance during high school years prior to graduation.

Qualifications:

- A. The applicant must complete the application form and provide the following letters of recommendation:
 - a. From the High School Principal, Guidance Counselor or Dean of Students
 - b. From a member of the Clergy
 - c. From your Employer (if employed) or a Business Professional from your Community

Requirements:

1. The recipient of the Scholarship Gift must provide a copy of grades semi-annually.
